

# Sorting guide for household waste

For detached and semi-detached houses in the municipalities of Aneby, Eksjö and Nässjö



## Waste bin

The waste bin should be placed, with the handles facing the road, 0–3 metres from where the refuse truck stops. No loose waste should be placed in the bin.



### Food waste

**WHAT?** Leftover food, whether cooked or raw, such as meat, fish, bones, fruit and vegetable peel, wilted cut flowers, tea bags and coffee grounds including filters.

**HOW?** Place in paper food waste bags, then in the food waste compartment. It is important that no plastic is placed in food waste bags.



### General waste

**WHAT?** That which remains once you have sorted your waste, such as cotton buds, razors, condoms, nappies, sanitary towels, tampons, dish cloths, plasters, dog waste bags, cat litter, vacuum cleaner bags, cigarette ends and snus.

**HOW?** Place in a sealed waste bag in the general waste compartment.

## Recycling stations

Packaging and newspapers are disposed of at the recycling stations operated by FTI.

*This applies until the introduction of kerbside collection in 2024–2027.*



### Plastic packaging

**WHAT?** Plastic tubs, plastic containers, styrofoam, plastic bags, plastic lids, empty plastic spray bottles.



### Paper packaging

**WHAT?** Cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard, paper bags, milk cartons.



### Glass packaging

**WHAT?** Coloured or clear glass bottles and jars.



### Metal packaging

**WHAT?** Cans, caps, metal lids, metal tubes, aluminium packaging.



### Newspapers

**WHAT?** Newspapers, papers, magazines.



## Electronics box

The electronics box should be kept indoors between collections and only be hung on the waste bin when a collection is due. You must be able to close the lid.



### Light sources

**WHAT?** Incandescent lamps, low-energy lamps, LED lamps.



### Batteries

**WHAT?** Batteries that fit in the box.



### Small electronics

**WHAT?** Charging cables, mobile phones, shavers, cameras, small speakers, electric toothbrushes.

## Recycling centres



**Other waste** such as bulky waste, hazardous waste, large electrical waste and reusable waste, can be disposed of at a recycling centre.

## Recycling centre locations

As a private individual, you are welcome to dispose of sorted waste at all our recycling centres.



### Aneby Municipality:

### Eksjö Municipality:

**Ingatorp Recycling Centre,** Reningsverket 1 on trunk road 40.

**Eksjö Recycling Centre,** Svarvgatan 4. You need to register your details before visiting. Register your details and check opening hours at [www.eksjoenergi.se](http://www.eksjoenergi.se).

### Nässjö Municipality:

**Boda Waste Plant.** If you are registered in a municipality other than Nässjö or do not have a driving licence, you need to order a key card before visiting. Order a key card and check opening hours at [www.nav.se](http://www.nav.se).

## Tips for food waste bags



- The paper bag should be kept in the holder we provide.
- Do not fill the bag above the dotted line.
- Change the bag often, at least every three days, even if it is not full.
- Allow wet food waste to drain in the sink or a colander before putting it in the bag.
- If necessary, line the bag with some used kitchen paper to absorb any moisture.
- Close the top of the bag tightly before placing it in the bin to avoid making a mess.

## Tips for painless waste collection

### Summertime

- Keep food waste dry to avoid a messy waste bin.
- Wash your bin often.
- Keep the bin in the shade between collections.



### Wintertime

*Before the collection:*

- Clear snow from and then sand the area around and route to your waste bin
- Clear snow from the lid.
- Ensure that bags are placed loosely in the bin. Shake the bin and free any bags frozen to the sides.

## Where can I collect food waste bags?

**Aneby Municipality:** Recycling centre, Ica Supermarket Lönner, Asken parish hall, Bälaryds bygdegård, Haurida: at the church, Frinnaryds bygdegård, Thelegården car park. Marbäck: church car park, Lommaryd: parish hall car park, Lövviken: by the post boxes, Sunhult byalag, Vireda recycling station.

**Eksjö Municipality:** Willys, ICA and Coop in Eksjö, Hulthallen, Eksjö Recycling Centre (Svarvg. 4), Ingatorp Recycling Centre, Eksjö Energi's office (Teleg. 8), Lundbergslivs in Hjaltevad, ICA in Mariannelund.

**Nässjö Municipality:** Civic centres in Bodafors, Anneberg, Forserum and Malmbäck. Flisby AB (Syredav.), Sandsjöfors Livs (Patriksv. 2), Barkös Handel (Svalöv. 11), Boda Waste Plant. Nässjö: Coop, ICA Kvantum, Willys, NAV's office (Tullg. 2).
